HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- ◆ Call Diane Myers at 920-0411 or email dmyers@MorningStarChoices.com to order your bottles and arrange for pick-up or delivery. Distribute the bottles to your congregation/school/group on a designated day. Families/students take the bottles home and fill them with coins, bills and/or checks. Four to six weeks later, they return the bottles on the date you choose. You collect the filled bottles and deliver them to Diane Myers at Morning Star. (or we can make arrangements for pick-up) We take care of the counting and processing and will let your church know the total amount raised.
- ◆ The starting and ending dates are usually **Mother's Day through Father's Day or in January which is Sanctity of Human Life Month** or any other time that works for you. Use this time to pray for the moms and babies at Morning Star and to speak to your own children about how special God created them (Psalm139). This is a great opportunity to teach your children about giving to help others.
- ◆ Two important criteria for the success of this project – Publicize it several weeks before and during the campaign in bulletin announcements. (See sample enclosed) and make the bottles conveniently available on the day of distribution. You can make a creative display in your church foyer by placing the bottles in a bassinette (tied with balloons). Bottles can also be placed in wicker baskets lined with a baby blanket. The baskets can be displayed on a table with baby toys, stuffed animals, etc. to bring attention to the display. **Recruit ushers or children to help distribute the bottles at each exit door of the church after each service. In the school setting, bottles can be distributed through home-room teachers.**
- ◆ Have a designated return area and have your church representative check it regularly. Keep the returned bottles in a secure location until the ending date. When you have collected the most of the bottles, bring them to Morning Star, or call us and we'll come pick them up. (920-0411). There is no need for you to process the coins. We will do it for you and notify you of the amount your church/group raised. Proceeds from this event will help Morning Star continue offering practical assistance and life-giving alternatives to abortion to thousands of women in our area considering abortion.
